

YLI SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarship program of the Young Ladies' Institute was inaugurated in 1925. Each of the following scholarships are awarded on an annual basis:

ASSOCIATE DEGREE SCHOLARSHIPS*

Two \$200 scholarships are available to students beginning the final year of an Associate Degree program or the final year in college with preference given to those in the Health Science field. If there are no qualified applicants in the Health Science field, scholarships will be awarded to qualified applicants in other fields.

ELLA M. COMYNS & AGATHA J. McDONALD SCHOLARSHIPS*

Each \$500 scholarship is available to students who are in the third or fourth year in an accredited program with preference given to those in the Health Science field. These scholarships, if awarded in the third year, will carry through the fourth year when all requirements are met. If there are no qualified applicants in the Health Science field, scholarships will be awarded to qualified applicants in other fields.

ENID OLIVI SHOOR SCHOLARSHIP*

A \$400 scholarship is available to a student in the third or fourth year of an accredited Liberal Arts program.

NOTE:

*These scholarships may be awarded in an amount larger than listed dependent on the growth of the Scholarship Endowment Fund.

CENTENNIAL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

An \$1,800 scholarship is available to a graduate student or a student in the third or fourth year of a college or university, or to a student in a graduate program of a college or university

MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIP

A \$2,000 fellowship (payable over two years) is available to a graduate student.

125th ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP

Two \$750 scholarships offered to a student attending a four-year college or university or to a student attending a two-year community college, junior college or trade school. Applicants must submit an essay with information regarding financial need and personal or educational goals.

THE CAROLYN E. JACKSON SCHOLARSHIP

A \$600 scholarship to a student wishing to continue her education by attending a two year college, junior college or four year university. The recipient of this scholarship may choose to continue her education in any field of her choice. Applicants must provide proof of enrollment or acceptance to the institution or college of their choice. They must also submit an essay with information regarding financial need and personal or educational goals.

THE ALMA ROSE SCHOLARSHIP

A \$1,000 scholarship to a student wishing to continue her education by attending a college, university, or vocational school. The recipient of this scholarship may choose to continue her education in any field of her choice. Applicants must provide proof of enrollment or acceptance to the institution or college of their choice.

Eligibility: All applicants must be members of YLI for at least one year and in good standing and must comply with all the Requirements for Scholarship Applicants recorded in the Constitution.
